- Help develop well researched investment theses based on macro and industry trends
- Review and summarize confidential investment memoranda
- Support business due diligence and financial analysis of new investment opportunities

 Conduct general industry or company specific research and analysis and special projects in support of portfolio companies

- Fundraising and investor relations support
- Internal process improvement support
