SHELTER



Stay at Byrne House Family Shelter or Hixon House Adult Shelter while you work to become financially stable and to secure permanent housing.



CHILDREN'S EDUCATION



Additional shelter programs include after-school, preschool and vacation components for children which take place at the Beverly Fowle Fiertz Community Center.



ADULT LEARNING



Adult programs which focus on emotional well-being, life skills and connections to community resources.

COMMUNITY SERVICES INCLUDE:

FOOD



Households in need can come to the Haven's Food Shelf for a week's supply of healthy groceries once a month. Bread is always available 24 hours a day, every day, and additional visits for local produce can be made during business hours.



COMMUNITY CASE MANAGEMENT



Case Managers will work with you to find immediate resources, short-term solutions and referrals to community organizations for anyone struggling with issues related to poverty or basic needs.



CLOTHING



Come to the Haven to "shop" the Haven's Clothing Room for free, donated, seasonal clothing.



SHOWER



The Haven's shower is available to anyone in need.
