Stories Growing Films (SGF) Narrative Script Submission Rules and Guidelines

1. Narrative scripts must be properly formatted according to the guidelines found here http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Screenplay

You may use free programs like Celtx or Final Draft (available as a free download from the College) to format your screenplays correctly. Scripts not following these guidelines will be sent back to be revised or not accepted by Stories Growing Films.

- 2. For documentary script submission guidelines, please see the other attached document.
- 3. Scripts should be between 8-25 pages long. Note that this is a guideline and you will not be penalized for shorter or longer scripts, but 40 pages is the absolute upper limit for script submissions.
- 4. The contest is open to current Dartmouth undergraduates and graduate students.
- 5. People from outside the Dartmouth community may enter only if they have co-written a script with someone who meets the criteria for number 4.
- 6. No more than four co-writers to a script.
- 7. If selected, scripts may be edited for content, clarity, and feasibility.
- 8. Please send your submissions with your name(s) **excised** to <u>sgfvote2013@gmail.com</u>. NOT OUR CLUB BLITZ ACCOUNT. Your submission should contain only the title of your work and nothing else. Scripts must be submitted in PDF format. Any other files will be discarded.
