## **Requirements:**

- Attend monthly Green Key Society meetings (1<sup>st</sup> Thursday of the month from 12-1pm)
- Volunteer to work either Commencement or Orientation AND Bonfire. (\*\*GKS cords for graduation will only be given to students who completed this requirement)
- Be on campus summer term and at least one other term during the year.
- If on campus, you must be an active member of the GKS. This includes attending meetings, working events such as Winter Carnival and Green Key Weekend.
- Must be in good standing with the college
- Must be dedicated to providing service to Dartmouth College
