Shake Out Info

Dates: Saturday, September 26th 5:00-8:00pm
Sunday, October 4th 2:00-5:00pm

Location: Our house, 15 Webster Avenue

About the event:

- Coming to our Shake Out is non-binding — attending Shake Out does not guarantee that you will receive a bid, nor does it require you to accept a bid should it be offered to you.
- Your Rho Chi will not take you to Shake Out; you will come on your own or with friends.
- Before attending Shake Out, you must attend both a GLOS education session and a DBI overview session.
- You do not need to attend a Panhellenic Recruitment info session in order to attend Shake Out.
- Attending Shake Out is the only way to receive a bid from Theta this winter, since we are not participating in formal recruitment.
- You do not need to come at the beginning of the event.
- You do not need to stay the whole time — you may stay for as long as you feel you need to in order for us to get to know you and for you to get to know Theta.
- You can go to both Shake Outs, but you do not need to attend both in order to be eligible to receive a bid from us.
- You can go to the second Shake Out even if you didn't go to the first one.
- You are welcome at Shake Out even if you have never been to our house or don't know a Theta (in fact, if both of these things are true, we'd love to meet you!)
- You may come with friends, and you may express interest in joining our house as a group.
- The event is casual — wear whatever you feel comfortable in; there is no official dress code.
- You will hear from us about whether or not you've received a bid within 24 hours of the event.
- Unlike formal recruitment, we do not use a computer system.

About its relation to formal recruitment:

- You can go to the first Shake Out and still go through formal recruitment, *unless* you accept a bid from us.
- You can go to the second Shake Out if you dropped out of formal recruitment in Rounds 1 or 2.
- You can go to the second Shake Out event and still go to Pref Night.
- If you turn down a bid that we offer you, you may still go through formal recruitment and get a bid to another sorority.
- If you turn down a bid that we offer you, it will not inhibit you from going through formal recruitment.
