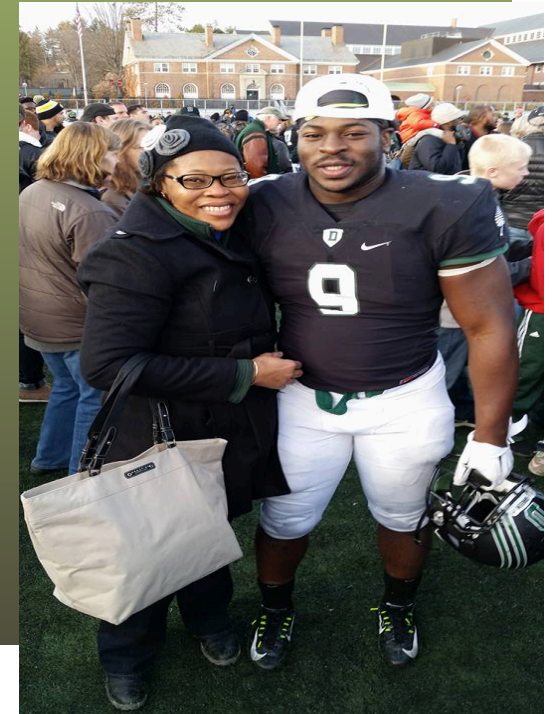

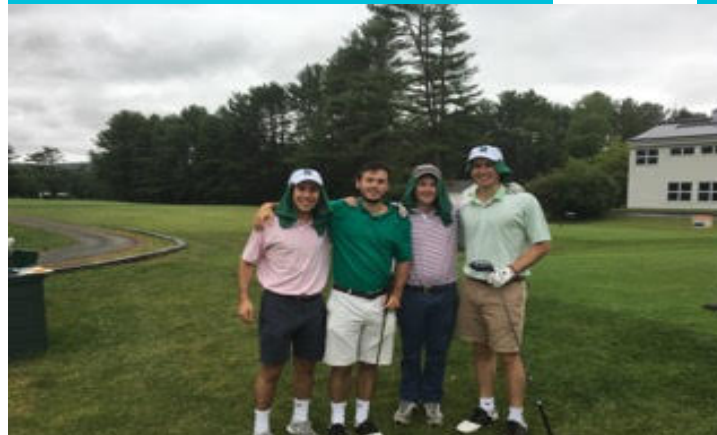
Academic Activities
