Introducing The Kelsey Community at Edgerton House

Edgerton House (known as 'The Edge') is the home of Episcopal Campus Ministry, the college ministry of St Thomas Episcopal Church. Since 2009 we have offered up to six places to undergraduate and graduate students to live in an Episcopal community. If you are looking for an alternative to Greek Life but want a sense of community that is also different from dorm life, read on.

Potential residents must be: a) committed to participating in the life of Episcopal Campus Ministry, b) committed not to discriminate against others on the basis of sexual orientation, gender, race, class, or religious belief, c) open learning new things about faith and being part of a community that delights in questioning assumptions, d) committed to working for peace and justice on the Dartmouth campus and in the wider world.

Accommodations include a furnished single or double bedroom at the Edge, depending upon the number and preference of the applicants, a full bathroom shared by residents but closed to the public, a washer and dryer, and shared use of the kitchen and living room, study room, chapel, and basement.

Rent at the Edge is based on a Dartmouth residence hall rate, discounted by 20%. By actively participating in the Kelsey Community and in Edgerton House, students are also contributing to our corporate life. For the 2014-2015 school year, rent is \$2,210 per term. In addition, each student is required to pay a \$100 security deposit, which will be returned to students upon leaving their rooms clean and in the same shape as when they moved in. Parking spaces are \$125 per term, a 50% discount.
