Background Information and Requirements:

DIPP is a student organization with a dual focus on active investing and philanthropy. In addition to providing a platform for undergraduate students to learn about finance through analyzing, pitching, and investing in stocks, DIPP also gives back to the greater Dartmouth community. This year, DIPP will be donating upwards of \$10,000 of its capital gains to fund student-initiated philanthropic endeavors.

DIPP is now accepting applications for individual grants up to \$3,000 for campus groups that are involved in community service or furthering social justice locally, regionally, or globally.

Applications will be evaluated on four primary criteria: the organization's presence on Dartmouth's campus, effectiveness of use of the grant, availability of alternative funding sources, and the timeframe for the project's completion. **Please note that grant award decisions for current projects will be made independently of past distributions.**
