### UCLA

Nestled in the heart of beautiful Westwood in Southern California, UCLA Law is less than seven miles from the Pacific Ocean and part of the 419-acre UCLA campus. UCLA Law is consistently recognized as the nation's premier school for entertainment and media law, and remains at the cutting edge of experiential opportunities in criminal and immigration law.

### Boston University
