Meet Up

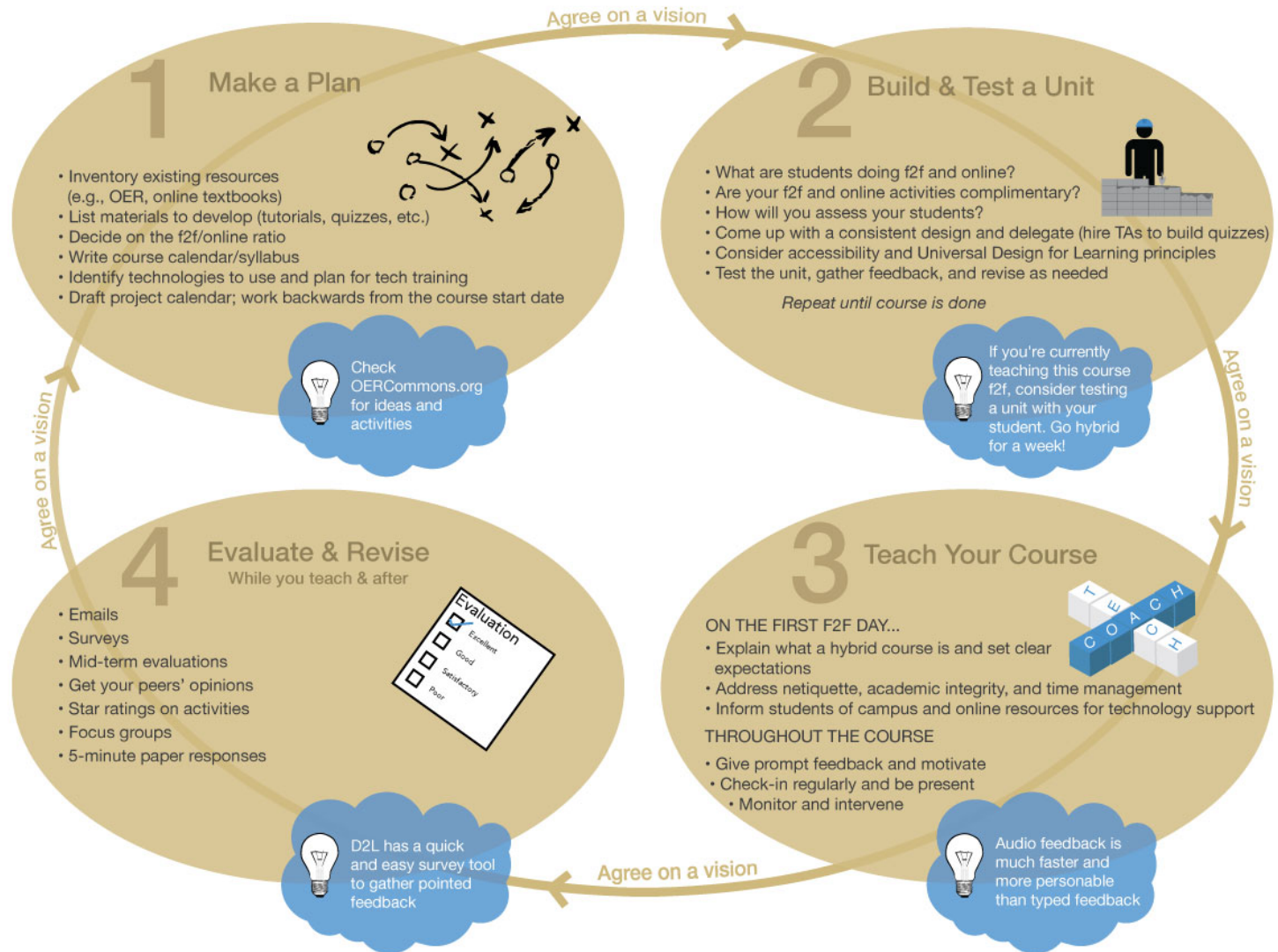
Set up a meeting with all collaborators to discuss responsibilities, course launch date, budget, general vision for the course, and existing resources.



What's Going Up?

Decide on the amount of your course to put online.

Hybrid 1: 33-50% of the course is online.
Hybrid 2: 50-80% of the course is online.
Online: 80% and up is online.
