CAPABILITIES



★ • Creates single package file avoiding issues during research data transfer

★ • Captures checksums for packaged research data objects, allowing for end-to-end verification of object integrity



Allows for expression of relationships among packaged research data objects and external resources



CHALLENGES

- Creating package on one system and augmenting research data on another system, possibly with a different OS (Resolved?)
- Using the application from an external hard drive connected to a researcher's system
 - Need JRE
 - Encounter a variety of OSs, disk formats
- We do not rely solely on the Tool but in general try to use it first
