Teaching for Inclusion

The Active Learning Institute (ALI) helps Dartmouth faculty develop and implement evidence-based teaching strategies in their courses that will engage students, deepen learning and make teaching more efficient, effective and enjoyable. This year, ALI has a thematic focus on active learning for inclusion.

By the end of ALI participants will be able to

- Create learning environments that welcome, challenge, and support students of all backgrounds, abilities and needs
- Recognize and articulate explicit and implicit learning outcomes for students and align course design and teaching activities accordingly
- Determine which active learning strategies are useful for particular student learning goals, and strategies that address diverse student populations and differences in opinion
- Identify tools and techniques that can be used to support active learning
- Describe basic cognitive science principles and their relationship to learning
- Access appropriate college resources to support their teaching and course design

Participants will receive a \$500 stipend for full participation in the two-day institute. Anyone holding a faculty teaching appointment at Dartmouth at any rank (Arts and Sciences, Engineering, Tuck, Geisel) is eligible to apply.

The ALI planning committee will select a cohort of participants based on the following criteria:

- Congruence between your goals and ALI program goals as specified above
- Desire to form a cohort that can learn from and with each other.
