

2023-2024 Geisel Early Assurance Program Application Instructions

Thank you for your interest in the Geisel School of Medicine’s Early Assurance Program! Below you’ll find instructions on how to fill out and submit the application. 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Accessing the Application

The application is now OPEN! Make sure to follow the below steps to apply.

- Fill out the [UPDATED Geisel EAP Application](#), which now includes a “Most Meaningful Activities” section. The password to access it is: dEAP23gsom
- NOTE: As you’re working on your application, make sure to save your progress frequently. Every time you return to your application, you will need to enter the password to access it.
- DO all your writing in Word, Google Docs, or another writing tool before copying and pasting to the application itself.
- After you are finished filling out the application, and if you have ACT/SAT scores (a screenshot will suffice), make sure to submit using the below Qualtrics link.

Application Checklist

Your application file will not be considered complete unless the following materials are received by the Geisel Admissions Office (Three Rope Ferry Road, HB 7020, Hanover, NH 03755).

- A **completed application** with both certification boxes checked.
- A non-refundable **application fee** of US \$130 in a check (or money order) payable to the Geisel School of Medicine. This fee may be mailed to us at the address above or dropped off at the Admissions Office. If you would like to request a fee waiver, please contact Aileen.K.Panitz@dartmouth.edu.

- **Two to five letters of reference.** We suggest that at least two be authored by science faculty, including one from a faculty member who taught you in a required pre-medical course. You may also include letters from people who have seen you in extracurricular, volunteer, or employment settings. Letters should clearly state that you are an applicant to the Geisel School Early Assurance Program. Letter **MUST ALSO INCLUDE LETTERHEAD AND SIGNATURE!**
- **Official transcript(s)** from each post-secondary institution at which you have taken classes. You should make a request to the Registrar to send your transcript directly to Geisel. Instructions on how to make a request are here: <https://www.dartmouth.edu/reg/transcript/>
- A report of the **scores of the standardized testing** (SAT I or ACT, with writing, and SAT II) that accompanied your college applications. You may self-report your scores to us via email at Geisel.Admissions@dartmouth.edu or upload them along with your application using the above Qualtrics link.
- **Supplemental materials** and/or updates may be submitted by emailing them to us at Geisel.Admissions@dartmouth.edu. We will accept email updates throughout the application process.

Application Essay Prompts

1. Please provide an essay telling us how your background, experiences, and your interests motivate you to pursue medicine. You may choose to write about challenges or obstacles you have overcome, activities that have sparked your interest, or experiences that have led you to want to become a doctor (5,300 character limit).
2. The Geisel School of Medicine values social justice and diversity in all its forms. Reflect on a situation where you were the “other,” (no character limit).
3. Please reflect on your application and share something not addressed elsewhere that would be helpful to the Admissions Committee as we review your file (no character limit).

Deadlines

You will have until **SUNDAY, OCTOBER 8TH AT 11:59 PM** to submit your application. Geisel will begin reviewing applications immediately after the deadline. **Your letters of recommendation are also due on the above date.** To learn more about the letter process, please read the Geisel EAP Letter Packet Instructions.
