

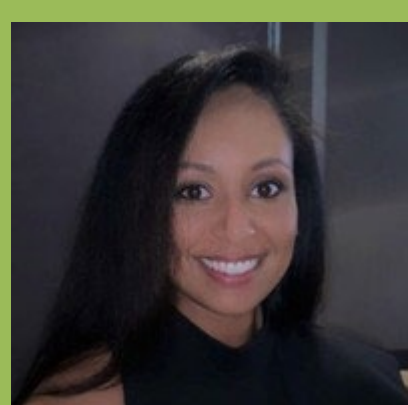

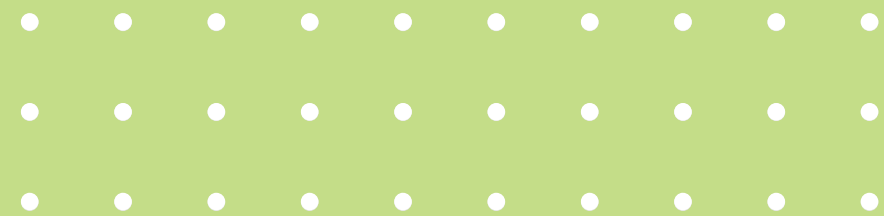

# DESIGN YOUR OWN INTERNSHIP

internship requirements

- Completed over a leave term
  - 8 – 10 weeks, 40 hours/wk
  - Internship must be unpaid
  - Internship must be In-person
  - Internship must be with a registered nonpartisan nonprofit serving an under-resourced community in the U.S. or U.S. territories
  - Receive up to \$5,500 stipend from DCSI
  - Interns are matched with an alumni mentor through [DPCS](#)



  - Dakota Child and Family Clinic (Burnsville, MN) – low cost primary care services to uninsured and underinsured patients
  - Johns Hopkins Center for Indigenous Health (Duluth, MN) – Indigenous well-being and health
  - Health Leads (San Francisco, CA) – racial health equity
  - The Global Medical Relief Fund (NYC) – assists children affected by war



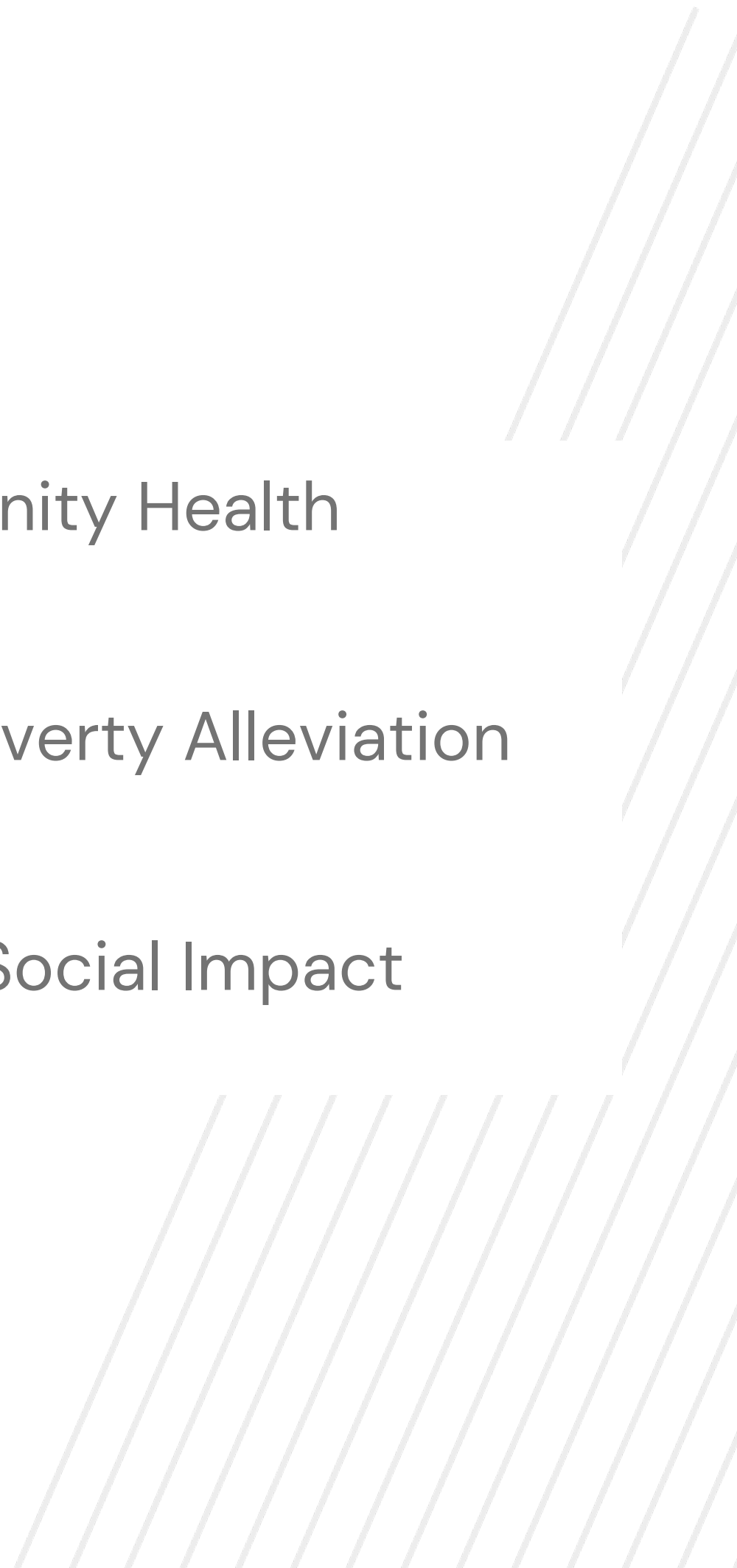



examples of previous work

- resource coordination for patients and families who use the health services provided by the partner organizations and involve a high degree of interpersonal interaction requiring determination and proactivity.
  - work with people who are unstably housed, many of whom use substances. The work done in these roles includes patient navigation, program support, harm reduction outreach, and housing assistance

# OTHER DCSI FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES



- ImpACT Winterim Leadership Intensive – Work on a 3-week project during winterim with a non-profit and earn a \$1,500 stipend.
  - 82 Upper Valley Community Impact Fellowship - Up to \$8,000 living stipend to work / complete project for local nonprofit over 3-4 terms
  - Olga Gruss Lewin Fellowship (Post-graduate) Up to \$30,000 to work / implement project for nonprofit over 9-12 months after graduation
