## **Program Itinerary**

## Beijing, Guilin and Shanghai

03/23 Boston to SFO SFO to Beijing

Depart from Boston connecting to San Francisco and your Air China or China Eastern Air jetliner to Beijing. Cross the International Date Line and lose one day.

#### 03/24 ARRIVE BEIJING

Arrive in Beijing, the capital city of China, and Check into the Five-star Wanda Realm Beijing Hotel or similar.

#### 03/25 BEIJING (AB, L, D)

Today's sightseeing includes Tiananmen Square, the Forbidden City where the emperors of Ming Dynasty and Qing Dynasty ruled China and Beijing Zoo. After lunch, Drive by the Olympic Venue of "Bird's Nest" stadium. Performance will be arranged at Beijing University in the performing center.

#### 03/26 BEIJING (AB, L, D)

In the morning, take a coach to the Great Wall, a symbol of China and a fantastic sight that can never be omitted. Your group will do a brief performance at the Great Wall entrance plaza and a special group picture will be taken at the Great Wall, and then visit the Jade Factory. In the afternoon, visit the beautiful Summer Palace, the traditional emperors' summer residence. Enjoy Beijing Duck Banquet in the evening.

#### 03/27 BEIJING / GUILIN (AB, L, D)

Fly to Guilin . After lunch, you will visit the Reed Flute Caves . Welcome Banquet will be hosted by the Tourism Administration of the city government and other local officials. Check into the five-star Lijiang Waterfall Hotel or similar. http://www.waterfallguilin.com

#### 03/28 GUILIN (AB,L.D)

Today, you are invited by the American Flying Tiger Delegation and City Government of Guilin to attend the Celebration Ceremony of the 70th Anniversary of the Anti Fascism WWII with the veterans and representatives from all walks of life from the region and perform for them at the the Yangtang Old Airport once was used by the Flying Tigers during the World War II where now the Flying Tiger Park Museum is built. Top off the event with the Dedication Ceremony of Artifacts Presentation to the Flying Tiger Park Museum by American Flying Tiger Historical Organization with the Flag-Raising Ceremony(American flag, Chinese flag and the Flying Tiger flag raising together). In the evening, Joint performance with Chinese performing groups from the College of Music of Guangxi Normal University. Social exchange will be arranged after the performance.

#### 03/29 GUILIN/YANGSHUO/ SHANGHAI (AB, L, D)

Spend the day aboard a scenic Li River cruise, passing picturesque farms and fishing villages with its thousands of limestone outcroppings, Guilin has been the inspiration for generations of silk scroll painters. In the late afternoon, visit the Elephant Trunk Hill, Tea Production Factory. #### 03/30 SHANGHAI (AB, L, D)
