The Art House Convergence is pleased to offer scholarships to the 2016 Art House Convergence. Its Scholarship Fund, which offered several registration-only scholarships last year, is supported by Boston Light & Sound and will offer several comprehensive scholarships this year.

Scholarships will be awarded on a merit basis, with a small committee reviewing the applications. Theatres are welcome to apply even if they have registered other staff members - make the case in your statement as to why it is important for the applicant to attend the conference. If you have already registered for the conference, but would like to apply for a scholarship, please note you have already registered in your application.

Scholarships will be awarded to cover full conference registration fees (a \$695 value), a flight reimbursement up to \$500, and accommodations at the Homestead Resort for three nights (Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday). Scholarship receipients or their organizations are responsible for covering any additional conference-related expenses. There may be several registration-only scholarships available as well pending funding availability.

Please submit your application by November 6th, 2015. Scholarships will be announced by Friday, November 13th.
